He observes that his father was a whole-literate man, yet with such an appreciation of the value of learning as to furnish his children with a better start in life than he had had.

"I have often reflected," says Durant, "on this implication which seems to his device of knowledge every parent's hope to give the children a finer start than they have. Were not such a hope held after all, we utter a regrettable amount of nonsense on our marbles through the cycle, but we can give with a magnificent do-voition."

"One would have said that Durant was a confirmed pessimist if one had read his philosophical and economic writings only. A man can be a pessimist philosophically and economically. But when this cynical philosopher writes about his own family and his own experience with his wife and daughter, he is forced to become an optimist. The world may be gray with the gloom of wars, and the sun may be hidden by sinister clouds of doom, but beneath the clouds are within the most there will strike the flame of love, which warms the heart of humanity."

"I am inclined to agree with Mr. Durant that we are not such a bad lot, after all. I am even anxious to include philosophers in that 'we.' When people get to theorizing about the utility of life and the mistakes of an all-wise Providence, they can work up a pretty good case against God and man. They can even convince themselves that the creation is a sorry mess, and that man is an ignominious brute. And then comes love, and sets the clouds a-flying. Love of woman, love of man, love of family, child and race. The philosopher becomes human."

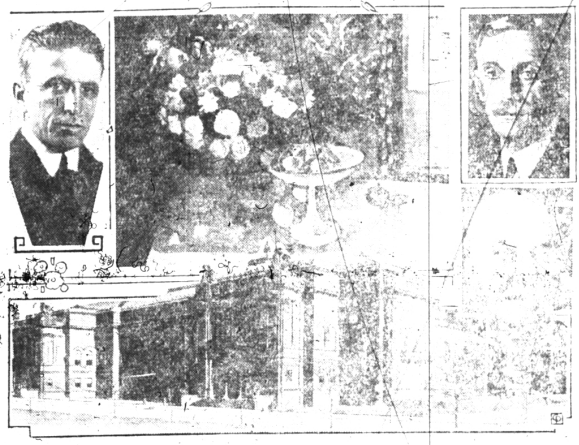

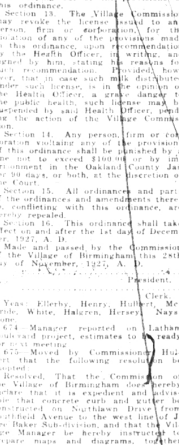

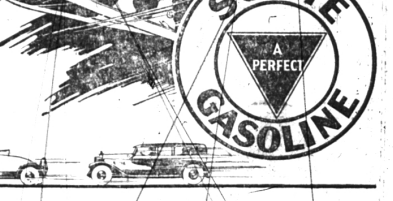
