

DR. PETERSON SPEAKER HERE

Pontiac Pastor Takes Jingle For Theme Of Rotary Address

Most people lack a definite purpose in life; they set a floating aim, they set a goal, they set an objective, while the average man is steadily directed with circumstances and environment.

That is what Dr. Paul Arnold Peterson, pastor of the First Presbyterian Church of Pontiac, told members of the Birmingham Rotary club at his Monday noon meeting at the Chateau Tea Room. He was the guest of S. O. Wiley Hall, Rotarian, and federal director.

Dr. Peterson took as the basis of his remarks the nursery jingle that reads "dir, dog, went to Dover, he came to a stile, hop, he went over the world where so many people lose their sense of direction, they needed to come back to the jingle of the dog that went to Dover to likened the ordinary difficulties of life to the stile in the jangle, and said that many people lacked the qualities that would permit them philosophically to surmount the barriers which they meet on the way.
