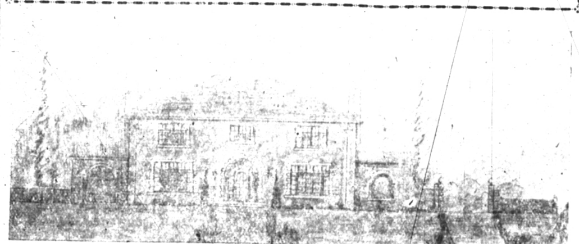
They left the place in a state of disorder, however, apparently having sought valuable watches, narcotics or gold, in the opinion of Sergt. Clark Green who investigated.
