D. 1927 at 12 o'clock M. Central Standard Time for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said District the proposition to authorize the District Board

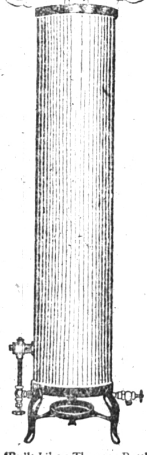
