NOTICE TO DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS

To all Owners, Possessors or Occupiers of Lands, or to any person or persons, firm or corporation having charge of any lands in this State:

NOTICE is hereby given that all Noxious Weeds growing on any lands anywhere within the

Township of Bloomfield - County of Oakland

State of Michigan, or within the limits of any highway passing by or through such lands, must be cut down and destroyed on or before the first day of July, A. D. 1927, in townships South of Range 16 North, and on or before July 15th in townships North of Range 16 North.

Failure to comply with this notice on or before the date mentioned or within ten days thereafter, shall make the parties so failing liable for the costs of cutting and destroying such weeds, to be levied and collected against the property in the same manner as other taxes are levied and collected; and shall be a lien upon the land until paid in full.

If any owner, possessor or occupier of land, or any person or persons, firm or corporation having charge of any lands in this State, knowingly, suffer any Canada thistles, milkweeds, wild parrots or other noxious weeds to grow upon or shall suffer the seeds to ripen, so as to cause or endanger the spread thereof, he or she shall, on conviction in any court of competent jurisdiction be liable to a fine of ten dollars, together with costs of prosecution, for every such offense and he or she shall pay the cost of cutting and destroying such weeds.
