NOTICE: \A special meeting of the legal voters of School District No. 1 Fractional, Townships of Bloomfield, Troy, Royal Oak and Southfield, Oakland County, Michigan, called by the District Board of said District, will be held in the Baldwin High School building in Rirmingham, Michigan, in said District on the 11th day of July, A. D. 1927, at 12 o'clock M. Central Standard Time, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said District the proposition to authorize the District Board-

To borrow the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) and to issue the bonds of the District therefor bearing interest at the rate of 4½ per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, both principal and interest to be payable at Birmingham, Michigan, said bonds to be dated June 15, 1927, and to mature:

June 15, 1935\$20,000
June 15, 1936 30,000
June 15, 1937 30,000
June 15, 1938 20,000
June 15, 1939 18,000
June 15, 1940 40,000
June 15, 1941 40,000
June 15, 1942 40,000

and to be numbered from 1 to 400, both consecutively and inclusively, and to be in the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) each, funds from said bonds to be used for the purpose of building and equipping a school building on Chesterfield road in said District and to build and to equip an addition to the Barnum school in said District.
