To all Owners, Possessors or Occupiers of Lands, or to any person or persons, firm or corporation having charge of any lands in this State:

NOTICE is hereby given that all Noxious Weeds growing on any lands anywhere within the

### Township of Bloomfield - County of Oakland

Township of Bloomfield - County of Oakland

State of Michigan, or within the limits of any highway passing by or through such lands, must be cut down and destroyed oil or before the first day of July, A. D. 1927, in townships South of Range 16 North, and on or before July 16th in townships North & Range 16 North.

Failure to comply with this notice on or before the date mentioned or within ten days thereafter, shall make the parties so falling liable for the costs of cutting and deskroying such weeds, to be levied and collected against the property in the same manner as other taxes levied and collected gainst shall be a lien upon the land until paid in full.

If any owner, possessor by occupier of land, or any person or persons, firm or corporation having charge of any lands in this State shall, knowingly, suffer any Canada thistles, milkweed, wild carrots or other noxious weeds to grow thereon or shall suffer the seeds to ripen, so as to case the control of the control of the sufficient of lable to a fine of ten dollars, together with costs of prosecution, for every such offerise and he or they shall, on conviction in any course of ferise and he or they shall on the costs of cutting and destroying such weeds.
