

Biennial Spring Election Notice and Annual Township Election

MONDAY, APRIL 4th, A.D., 1927 For the Purpose of Voting for the Election of the Following Officers, viz:

STATE—Two Justices of the Supreme Court, full term; two Regents of the University; one Super-intendent of Public Instruction; one Member State Board of Education; two Members State Board of Agriculture.

COUNTY-One County Commissioner of Schools.

TOWNSHIP—One Supervisor; one Township Clerk; one Township Treasurer; one Highway Com-missioner; one Justice of the Peace, full term; one member Board of Review, full term.

WHERE TO VOTE

PRECINCT No. 1—All that territory bounded North by West Maple Avenue, East by South Woodward Avenue to Lincoln Avenue and from Southfield Road and Lincoln Avenue by Southfield Road; South by Lincoln Avenue to Southfield Road and the Southfield Township Line; West by Township Line.

(Vote at Baldwin High School, West Maple and Chester Streets.)

PRECINCT No. 2—All that territory bounded on the North by Lone Pine Road; East by Troy Town ship Line; South by Lincoln Avenue; West by Woodward Avenue.

(Vote at Township Offices, First State Bank Bldg.)

PRECINCT No. 3—All that territory bounded on the North by the Township Line; East by the Township Line; South by Lone Pine Road; West by the Township Line.

(Vote at the Barbour Store, Woodward and Long Lake Road.)

PRECINCT No. 4—All that territory bounded on the North by Lone Pine Road; East by Woodward Avenue; South by West Maple Avenue; West by the Township Line.

(Vote at Harmon and Woodward, Village Booth.)

PRECINCT No. 5 (New Precinct)—All that territory bounded on the North by Lincoln Avenue, East by Woodward Avenue and Troy Township Line; South by the Township Line; West by Southfield Road.

(Vote at Eco City Booth.)
