MAN SEEN AS MANY ATTEND NEW CENTER BUREAU DINNER

Several Interests Occupy Royal Oak Credit Man's Bloomfield Hills Building

The opening of the new five-story building at Long Lake road and Woodward avenue, Birmingham, is being attended by a large number of business men and residents of Bloomfield Hills tonight at the Lone Pine Inn when a great dinner is being given to mark the establishment of business offices there. The building, on the southeast corner of Long Lake road and Woodward avenue, contains a number of stores besides the Inn, as well as all room upstairs, which is planned, will serve as a center of community activities. It was built by Mrs. M. J. Davis, of Bloomfield Hills, with an idea of community benefit in mind.

Seven of the eight stories, have already been rented, and most of them are open today. The greatest interest is being considered by an established business man, Mr. Davis said.

The A. M. Turner company has already opened the Bloomfield Hills Dress Shop in the building, with Mrs. Turner in charge. Mrs. Frazer, has the Fox and Hounds restaurant. The reputation of tea houses is high in this vicinity, where she at one time had charge of the Lone Pine Inn, and at present has the Fox and Hounds. The Fox and Hounds, which includes the inn proper and the hotel, is a branch of Hammel's Cafeteria, which is housed in the new building, where Hammel's home, as well as the customary food service, cigars, tobaccos and other necessities. A drug service in the Hammel's store will be operated by L. L. Armstrong, who has secured an agency for Standard Oil products to be sold in the building. A plumbing shop will serve as a branch of the new building, which will be operated by J. Butler, who has subdivided and put on the market Bloomfield Hills additional lots. The new building will move his office from west Long Lake road to the new building.
