BUREAU PLANS COLLECTIONS

TWO CITIES GET SUPERVISORS

Under Pontiac's new census of 54,000 population, it is entitled to two more supervisors making the city's representation on the Oakland County Board of Supervisors eight. Cities of population from 50,000 to 65,000 are entitled to eight supervisors.

Royal Oak city has a population of 18,209 persons which would give it a representation of five supervisors, one more than at present.

RAIN HALTS PLANT WORK

Yellow Truck Plant Construction Halted During Deluge Of Water

Heavy rains of last week held up the construction of the new Yellow Truck & Coach Manufacturing company plant in Bloomfield, Township.

Light pleasure cars and big trucks were able to navigate in the vicinity as long as they stayed to the main road, which was covered with water a foot deep, but had a solid foundation.

Steel workers start work on the erection of Section "D" steel. This work was stopped early on Thursday with about half of the steel for this fourth section in place.

The temporary drain constructed to carry off the water into the new Pontiac Creek Drain is completed were adequately carrying the great volume of water this morning, but indications were that they could not stand a much larger volume.

Administration Building Foundation work for the administration building was also stopped and it will require many hours to pump out the water before the work can be resumed.

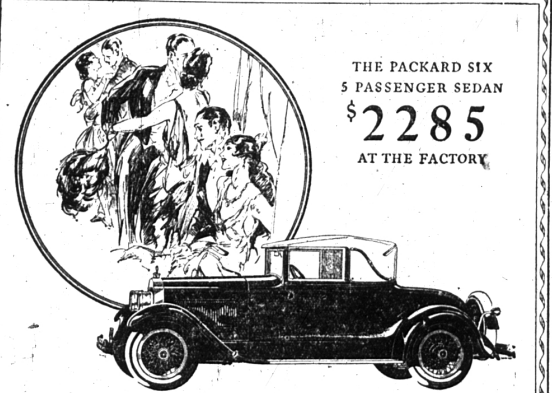
