WORK STARTS ON JAIL BLOCK

Completion Of Cells To Be Rushed At County Jail
 Work is under way today on the completion of the two new cell blocks in the Oakland County jail at Pontiac and Sheriff's officers see an early relief from the crowded conditions at the jail. Accommodations for 128 men and several women are being provided in the new cell blocks.
 Blocks on the third and fourth floors were left unfinished when the jail was constructed because of a lack of funds for the purpose. The capacity of the jail will almost be doubled when the new blocks are ready for occupation. Each of the new cells will be 13x9 feet and will hold four bunks.
 At the north end of the building on the third floor a daylight room is being built which will serve as a dining and sitting room.
 Three cartons of material have already been received and work is progressing at the jail now without a hitch. With continued good fortune it is possible that the work may be completed within six weeks. Harry Van Bogart is directing the work here for the Van Dorn Iron Works of Cleveland, estimates.
 This company was awarded the contract and did the installing of the cell blocks now in use. The new blocks are of the same type. They are considered as the most modern. It is possible to obtain steel technically known as fireply, which it is impossible to cut without a torch, is being used. A trained crew of men sent from Cleveland is doing the work.

LIBRARY SETS NEW RECORD

Circulation Figure Is Highest In History Of Institution

EXPECT TO OPEN OFFICE BUILDING

J. E. Burris Structure On Pierce Street Nearing Completion
 Announcement is made today of the opening of the new offices and storehouse of J. E. Burris, builder, on Pierce street just south of Brown. Mr. Burris expects to be in the new quarters by the first week in October.
 The building, which is rapidly nearing completion, is of the English type of architecture. The exterior is of brick and the sloping roof is shingled. It is two stories high.
 The first floor will be used for offices and garages for the delivery trucks used in the business. Stores also will be included on this floor.
 The second floor will be divided between a storehouse and a work shop. It is planned to keep the building materials in the storehouse which will always be available and so the cost will be reduced.
 Architectural offices, in charge of Ernest Platman, will be included in the new building.
