**ORDINANCE NO. 13**

An Ordinance Relative to the Election and Organization of Hill Boards in the Village of Bloomfield Hills, Michigan.

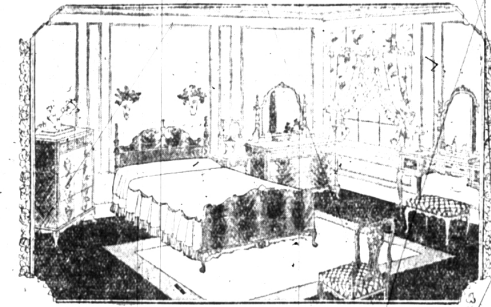

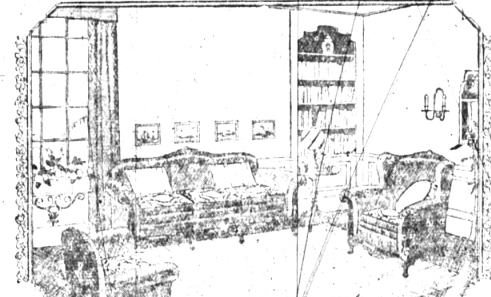

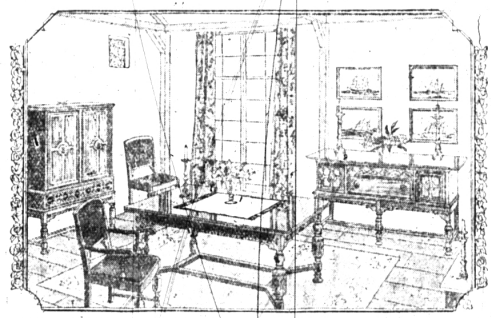
