Supreme Court Rules "The constitutionality of the railroad has been thoroughly tested in a case recently decided by the supreme court. In that connection I desire to call your attention to the fact that the whole legal attack against the contract was directed against precisely those parts of the old 1925 agreement which you changed in the instrument we now have. The new

agreement cured the legal defects in the old contract and thereby prevented a loss of at least a year's time, because in my opinion, had the change not been made as you suggested, the old contract would surely have gone down before the assaults made upon it and we could not have resumed work until after the 1929 legislature had cured the defects. We are now engaged in purchasing most of the needed right of way. In doing so we have found it advantageous to purchase more land than was actually needed, and are now disposing of this surplus.
