STATE EXPENSE FOR BUILDING HITS NEW HIGH

New Structures and Improvements Total Tops \$7,000,000

PROGRAM CURTAILED

(Special to The Eccentric)

Lansing, Aug. 28.—Authorized expenditures for new buildings and improvements at state institutions for the fiscal year ending June 30 last, totaled \$7,001,398, one of the largest amounts expended for such work during any one of the last 10 fiscal years of the state.

Notwithstanding this expenditure, the building program of the state was held down by Gov. Fred W. Green and the state administrative board, because of shortages in the general fund of the state.

Corporation Tax High

Money for all non-tax clause appropriation bills must come from the general fund of the state, and unless there is a surplus in this fund, no building operations can be carried out. The general fund is made up of current receipts, not specifically appropriated, and only the largest single items going into this fund is the corporation tax, which last year totaled about \$6,000,000.

The corporation tax this year, payable September 1, will not total more than \$4,500,000 due to a recent ruling by the Michigan supreme court to the effect that the state can not tax corporations for intangible assets held outside of the state.

Construction Items

Among the construction items authorized during the last year were \$30,000 for improvements at the Michigan College of Mines; \$75,000 for a new dairy barn at Michigan State College; \$10,000 for improvements at Newberry State Hospital; \$15,000 for fire walls at Traverse State hospital; \$350,000 for rebuilding the Howell Sanitarium; Michigan Soldier's Home; new women's building, and general repair work \$116,000; New Jackson Prison, \$1,237,164; new armory, Monroe, \$85,000; Improvements at Mackinac Island State Park, \$30,000; University of Michigan, \$1,211,805, including \$625,000 for museum building and equipment; \$27,000 for school architecture; \$300,000 for land for Women's league building and \$250,000 for modern elementary school.

The normal schools received: Michigan state, \$10,041; Central state, \$42,754, including \$420,000 for library and administration building; Western State, \$1,726; Northern State, \$16,218. Other work orders given included \$51,126 for repairs at Michigan College of Mines; \$21,000 at Michigan School for Deaf; \$7,668 at Michigan school for the Blind; \$329,000 at Michigan state college, of which there was used for building improvements, \$75,000; Chemistry building, \$100,800; Demonstration hall, \$139,000; Physic building, \$15,000; \$140,000 for continuation work on new Jackson prison in addition to the \$1,880,000 previously mentioned; \$4,465 for improvements at Marquette prison; \$6,606, at Ionia reformatory; \$17,549 at Kalamazoo State Hospital; \$44,675 at Pontiac State hospital; \$57,000 at Traverse City Asylum; \$29,000 at Ionia State hospital; \$46,553 for remodeling at State Public School; \$11,188 at Michigan Employment Institution for Blind; \$33,937 for repairs to armories; \$190,672 for improvements in forest fire, forestry and park division of state conservation department; \$137,573 for improvements at Michigan State Park; and \$85,000 for new state police barracks.

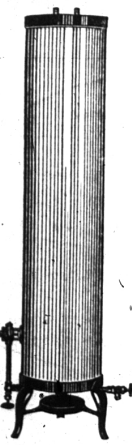
