

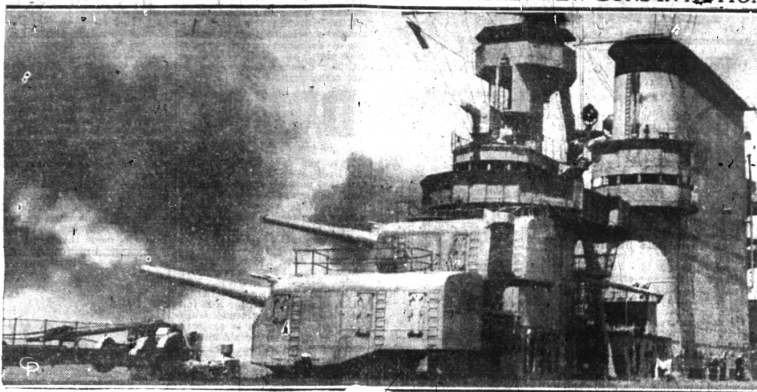

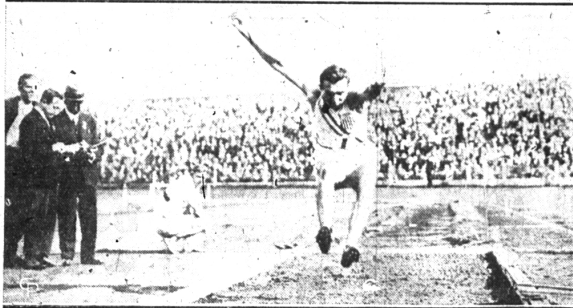

FIRST PICTURE OF UNITED STATES NAVY'S SECRET NEW GUNS IN ACTION



Here's the first picture permitted to be released by naval censors of the powerful new eight-inch guns aboard the airplane carriers Lexington and Saratoga in action. Above shows the U. S. S. Lexington firing her guns, which are unofficially credited with a range equal that of the great turret guns of the big dreadnaughts. The guns, which have been secretly developed during the last four years by naval experts, are said to give the carriers a potency unimpeded by any craft now afloat. This picture was taken off San Clemente island, near San Diego, Cal., during battle practice.

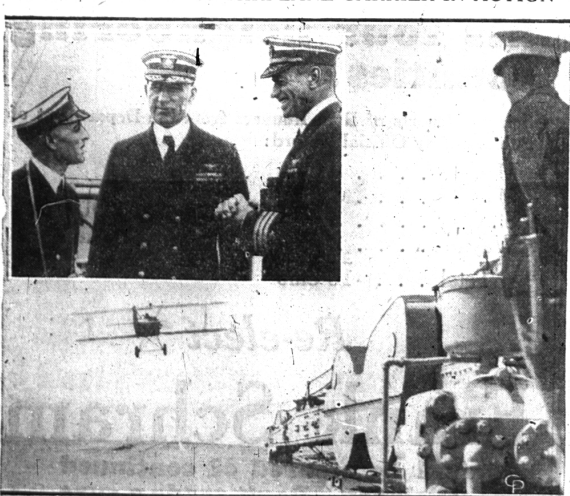

SEEING CANADA FROM AN ENGINE



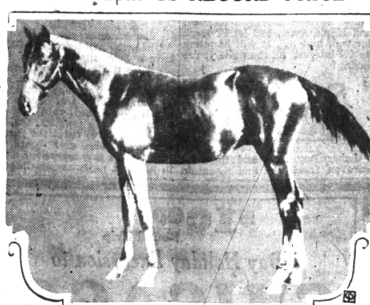

COLT BRINGS RECORD PRICE



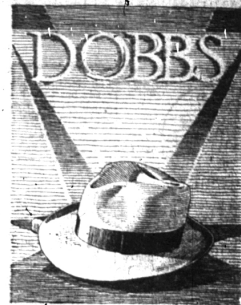
