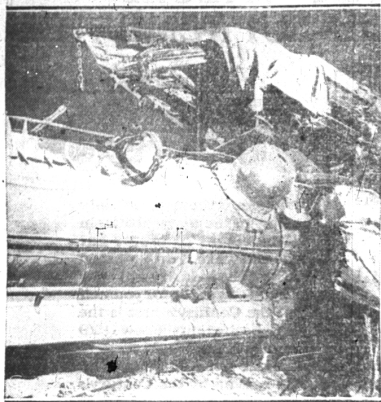

AIR MUSKETEERS IN WORLD FLIGHT



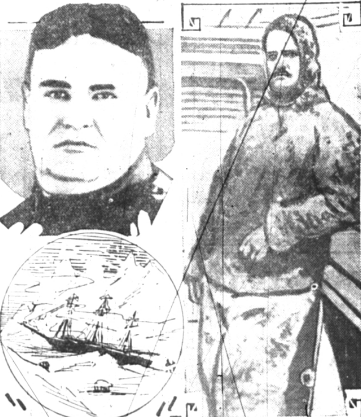
