INFLUENZA HERE IS MILD

 have been free from the infection, most of the cases being adults.

Clarence Vliet, superintendent of schools, said yesterday he did not believe it was necessary to shut down the schools because of the epidemic of influenza.

"While on Tuesday there were 500 students absent from the public schools out of an enrollment of 2290, all the absentees did not have influenza. Many of the children were kept from school as a precaution and for other causes. They were fewer absentees Wednesday both among the students and the six teachers who were out of school Tuesday."

Cherry Prepared
 The average absentee list from all public schools in Birmingham during the school year is about 100 a day, he said.

The condition throughout Oakland County is similar to that in Birmingham, according to a report from Dr. John D. Monroe, county health commissioner.

He indicated the disease up to date is not virulent but said the health department of the county is mobilizing its forces in case it develops seriously. Included in the plans is a provision for an emergency hospital in case hospitalization is necessary.
