(Continued from Page 4, Part 3) for authorized for the purchase of said streets and for the purchase of other lots and parcels in the said City of Birmingham, to-wit:

Whereas the sum of Fifty thousand (\$50,000) Dollars is necessary to extend the estimated cost of the taking of the said lots 44, 46, 48 and 49 of Merrill's Plat of the Village of Birmingham, as aforesaid.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Village Attorney prepare the necessary resolutions to submit to the electors of the Village of Birmingham the question of borrowing the sum of Fifty thousand (\$50,000) Dollars and issuing bonds therefor for the purpose of extending the estimated cost of the taking of the said lots 44, 46, 48 and 49 of Merrill's Plat of the Village of Birmingham, as aforesaid.

Whereas there was filed with the Commission of the Village of Birmingham under date of October 24, 1927, a petition signed by the requisite number of electors of the Village of Birmingham asking that the necessary steps toward the incorporation of the Village of Birmingham without change of boundaries as the City of Birmingham under the Home Rule for Cities Acts of the State of Michigan, be taken.

Whereas such petition is in accordance with the provisions and the statutes of the State of Michigan in such case made and provided; and

Whereas the Clerk of the Village of Birmingham has caused to be published the necessary notices as required under the Home Rule for Cities Acts of the State of Michigan in such case made and provided;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Village Attorney prepare the necessary resolutions to submit to the electors of the Village of Birmingham the question of borrowing the sum of Sixty-six thousand (\$66,000) Dollars and issuing bonds therefor for the purpose of extending the estimated cost of the taking of the said lots 44, 46, 48 and 49 of Merrill's Plat of the Village of Birmingham, as aforesaid.

Proposition 6 Shall the Village of Birmingham incorporate as the City of Birmingham under the Home Rule for Cities Acts of the State of Michigan? Yes.

Proposition 7 Shall the Village of Birmingham borrow the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) and issue the bonds of the Village therefor for the purpose of extending the estimated cost of the taking of the said lots 44, 46, 48 and 49 of Merrill's Plat of the Village of Birmingham, as aforesaid? Yes.

Proposition 8 Shall the Village of Birmingham borrow the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) and issue the bonds of the Village therefor for the purpose of extending the estimated cost of the taking of the said lots 44, 46, 48 and 49 of Merrill's Plat of the Village of Birmingham, as aforesaid? Yes.
