That any person, being a legal voter in said Township, who desires to become a candidate, for any of the several offices above set forth, may do so in the following manner, to-wit: in order to secure the placing of his or her name, as such candidate on the official ballot for the primary election to be voted for as a nominee for such office, is required to file with the Township Clerk, at least 20 days before the date of holding said primary election as herein before set forth, that said petition shall be signed by not less than one per centum and not more than four per centum of the voters of said Township as shown by the registration books thereof.

That said primary election will be held and conducted under the direction and supervision of three inspectors of election, from the qualified electors of said Township, appointed by the Township Board.
