A resolution lauding the work of the late Thomas Lytle, Oakland County road commissioner, is on record today following its adoption by the board of supervisors. The resolution follows:

Your committee appointed to draw resolutions commemorative of Thomas Lytle, recently deceased, and a member for many years of the board of county road commissioners for the County of Oakland since the creation of that board and the entering upon the era of good roads in this county, and

Whereas, during all of that time, Mr. Lytle has been a constant and an earnest advocate and supporter of every project looking toward the improvement of traffic conditions in Oakland County. While he was not a man who was given to lavish promises, yet he was at all times earnest, patient and constant in his devotion to the work for which he was chosen. He contributed, in a very large degree, to the development of the road system of Oakland County which began with practically nothing at the present time has grown until at the present time within the borders of this County there are more than 635 miles of hard surface and grave roads. To have played a part in the bringing about of that development is contributing no small amount to the prosperity of this county and the discharging of one duty, to one county is, in itself, a monument to his honesty, fidelity and patient persistence to this man.

Therefore, be it resolved, that in the death of Thomas Lytle the county has lost a valuable, conscientious servant who contributed the full measure of his energy and mental endowments toward its upbuilding and whose patient, tireless industry was a marked and valuable factor in his work for the public.

Be it further resolved, that this report and the resolutions be spread at length on the records of the board of supervisors for Oakland County and that a copy of the same, properly engrossed and signed by the chairman and clerk of the board, be delivered to the widow of Mr. Lytle.
