

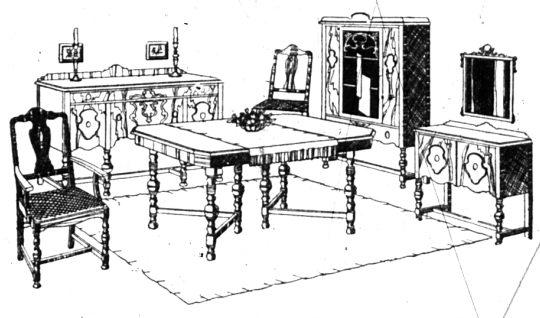

March 22, 1928.

JANUARY 1st, 1925 the Wolverine Manufacturing Company bought the land and buildings on Franklin Road at the Grand Trunk Railroad formerly owned and occupied by the Cartercar Company comprising about two hundred thousand feet of warehouse space and approximately seventeen and one-half acres of land, just off Saginaw street. We are well satisfied with our investment.

The buildings had already been opened up the year previous for warehouse purposes, storage of merchandise and automobiles, and successfully conducted. About the first of January we opened up a retail furniture business fashioned after the plan of a similar store farther north in the state believing that there was an actual demand for good furniture sold from old buildings where actual savings would be made over the prices of the average retail store from 25% to 35%.

We have been most successful in our undertaking. Month by month the business has rapidly increased. Where we had one light runabout, we are now operating five trucks and successfully delivering furniture over a radius of sixty miles.

We are selling the very best makes of furniture from Grand Rapids and elsewhere such as Berkey & Gay, The Simmons Company and many notable concerns.

We believe we are conservative in our statement when we say that we have the largest furniture stock in Oakland County comprising a broad variety of low priced, medium priced and better furniture.

It may be well to state that while we conduct a strictly retail business here and make these savings to the public, which has been most highly appreciated, we have had a broad manufacturing experience operating a furniture factory in Detroit for more than thirty years at Twelfth and Stanley. The property has been sold to one of the large automobile companies advantageously, and we decided to make our investment in Pontiac. We therefore, are able to keenly judge the quality of merchandise we are handling.

Due to the fact that we have a source of revenue from our warehouse business and the extremely low cost of our floor space and the further fact that we have side tracks into our buildings, our overhead is comparatively lighter and enables us to make savings from 25% to 35%.


