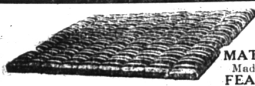

Tuberculosis Workers To Give Extensive Program In Pontiac Session

A large program is planned for the meeting and banquet of the Oakland County Tuberculosis Association Wednesday at 8 p. m. in the Roosevelt Hotel, Pontiac, according to announcement today by Zephia B. Hale, executive secretary.

Dr. James Stuart Prichard, specialist from the Battle Creek Sanitarium, will speak on the history of tuberculosis. The talk is to be illustrated with picture slides and many of the forms of modern treatment are to be illustrated.

PRaise GIVEN BOOK OF JOB

"The Book of Job, one of the world's greatest masterpieces. It appeals both to the imagination and to the reason, it represents the finest of the work of all the wisdom literature of the Hebrew, and at the same time contains the practical genius of the Hebrew nation."

This Rev. David Leon Woodward of the First Baptist Church introduced his sermon for last Sunday morning in the series of sermons on great men of the Bible, his subject being Job.

Rev. Woodward told the dramatic story of Job, the wealthy Arab sheik and told of his adventures in the plains of Uz. He described the meaning of Job and the Almighty according to the account in the book.

"Back of the patience of Job lies his faith in God. However dark his sky, he never lost his faith in God's possibilities. Job had dared to believe God dared to trust Him, dared to speak of Him as upon his side because he knew that he had been faithful to God," he said.

"The experience of Job teaches one great truth: The just shall live by faith." There are some things you cannot know and need not know; faith in God is sufficient to carry you through all troubles, and nothing but such faith is sufficient; this supplies the necessity of knowing.

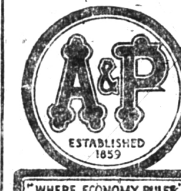
