VICTORY 6 SEDANS DIVIDE FRONT SEATS

Production of a limited quantity of Victory Six sedans, both de luxe and standard models, with divided adjustable front seats, has been announced by Dodge Brothers Inc. When seats are adjusted together, they give the appearance of a solid undivided seat.

Adjustments can be made quickly and easily by means of a locking handle to increase or diminish the leg room and steering wheel clearance in the front compartment. No tools are required, and with the locking handle raised it is possible to lift either seat from the car.

Announcement of a two-passenger coupe in the Senior Six line has been made. The car is built with a wide single seat extending across the body, and back of the seat is a carrying compartment providing for luggage.

The model also is available in the sport type, standard equipment including six wire wheels with two spares being mounted in front fender wells and special head lamps with nicked enclosures.
