Village Woman Succumbs After Acute Embolism Attack

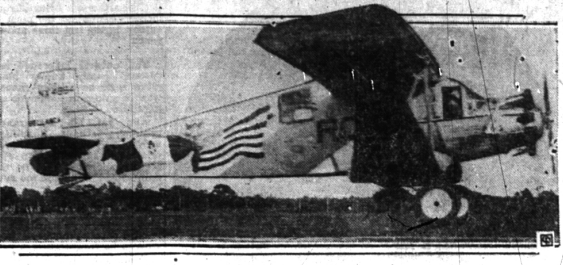
