"There is, for instance, the Friendly Indian group, the Pioneers and Torch clubs, the senior Hi-Y club, all of which are for boys. We again have the volleyball league for men in operation and the members are continuing to enjoy this work," he said.

The Y. M. C. A. has been active here 14 years, he said, and appears



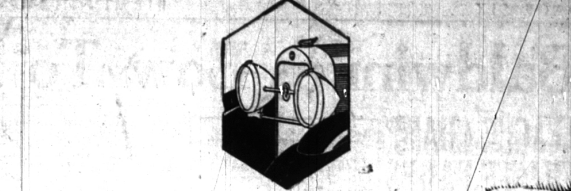
