This menu was planned for a day when housecleaning is on the program. Too much food to prepare on a busy day? The breakfast is easily and quickly prepared. The luncheon can be prepared in 15 or 20 minutes if the sauce and cookies are made. The roast is all ready to put in the oven with a small onion at each end of the pan and pepper and salt to season and half a cup hot water. It requires no further watching. The potatoes have been soaking and need only scrubbing and drying to put in the oven. The lettuce has been washed, the excess water shaken out and is put in a bag on ice ready to serve. The dessert is also prepared early in the day and put in the refrigerator ready to serve when the day's work is done and dinner served. It is hot, hearty and appetizing with a modicum into work.

Today's Recipes
Cream of Corn Soup—Put a tablespoon butter in a saucepan, let it melt and add a level tablespoon flour, mix well, gradually adding a quart of milk. Keep stirring until it comes to a boil, then add a can of corn which has been opened and emptied into a bowl to be ready. Season with salt and pepper and serve with crackers or toast strips.

Canned Peas—Put the peas into a baking dish, add salt, a pinch of sugar, a little pepper, and a lump of butter and put in the oven to heat through thoroughly.

Suggestion
When washing woolens, give them a final squeeze through clean soap-suds and let them dry with the soap in them. They dry readily, and remain surprisingly soft.
