

### EXPECT MANY AT M. S. C. 'FARM DAY'

Plans Made to Entertain State's Farmers At Lansing Tomorrow

East Lansing, Aug. 1.—Thousands of Michigan farmers and their families will gather on the state college campus here Friday, August 2, for the twelfth annual Summer Farmers Day.

With program arrangements completed, the college is prepared to play host for visiting agriculturists from every section of the state. More than 10,000 have attended some of these gatherings in recent years, and M. S. C. officials are predicting new attendance records if the weather is favorable on Friday.

Dedication of the new college dairy barns headlines a program which includes many new features, in addition to the usual opportunities for inspection of the college herds and flocks, and study of the hundreds of acres of experimental work along all lines of agricultural production.

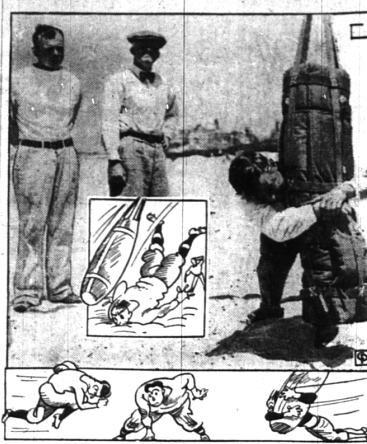
rol, use of the most modern farm machinery, and other subjects of timely value for farmers of the state.

A short general afternoon program will feature music by the national championship band from the Boys Vocational School in Lansing, and talks by A. J. Glover, editor of Hoard's Dairyman, and other farm leaders.

### SEEKS NEW GRANGE Illini Mentor Visions Famous "Galloping Ghost" On Western Teaching Trip

San Diego, Cal.—Bob Zuppke has come west, young men, seeking another "Red" Grange. He doesn't phrase the thought in those words. His actual summer "job," as he terms it, is teaching 50 western youths some of the fundamentals of football.

Stresses Tackling  
With memories of the famous "galloping ghost" in mind, he considers proper tackling one of the most important requisites for a player.

"Left foot forward, head down and face in," is his formula, repeated many times to the young hopefuls who listen daily to his lectures on the sands of the Pacific at Coronado, a suburb.

Zuppke has directed the Illini eleven for 16 years. For two years more than two decades he has been coaching. Never again, he believes, will he find the counterpart of the famous Grange.

Possibly the recent changes in football rules will have some effect in dimming the brilliance of the shining stars. Zuppke believes football is becoming a steadier game. The recent rule change forbidding a defensive player to run with a fumbled ball is a decided step in that direction.

"A good rule," he comments. "The fumble has the same status as a muffed ball. It takes away some of the elements of chance and helps permit a stronger team to win."

Zuppke has many calls during a summer for his teaching services. There are about 50 coaching schools in the country, and he received 12 invitations this year to teach.

Instead he came west to see what manner of youths grow out here and to impart in the halliwick of "Pop" Warner, the Stanford mentor, some of the Illinois football principles.

Like Warner, he teaches fundamentals—running, tackling, handling the ball—during summer and leaves it to other coaches to put the finishing touches on the players.

A Modest Coach  
So modest is Zuppke, however, that he sometimes finds it difficult in convincing people he really is the famous Illinois coach. On the way out he stopped with Mrs. Zuppke at a resort and introduced himself to a casual acquaintance.

"You can't fool me," she exclaimed. "I went to Illinois two years and you're not Bob Zuppke. I know him."

Whether he is known personally or by the nation as the mentor of one of the strongest members of the Big Ten—wherein he expects to have another winning team this autumn!

### NEARBY and YONDER... by T. T. Maxey

The Wisconsin Delta EOLOGISTS declare that once upon a time that section of the United States which is now designated as Wisconsin was covered by a massive sheet of ice—somewhat like the Greenland of today. This ice period probably came to an end some 50,000 years ago. As this far-reaching ice field began to melt and break up and Wisconsin took its place in the sun, the ice water escaped by cutting a channel through a sandstone ridge which ran crosswise to its course and the Delta of Wisconsin river came into existence and the river sought a connection with the Father of Waters so as to have an outlet for its liquid cargo.

The Delta extends some seven miles up and down the river, forming a minimum width of about 50 feet, a depth of from 60 to 120 feet, and their unusual beauty is the outstanding feature of this valley.

Here, for hundreds of centuries, nature's elements have quietly worked, wearing, carving and etching the sandstone ridge of the river into an ornate and unique feature, scenic attraction. Outstanding features have been appropriated and named by visitors. For instance, one finely chiseled lateral canyon is so narrow that two persons cannot pass at the same time—hence, "Fat Man's Misery." Bold cliffs, deep chasms, rising rock formations sculptured walls, fluted columns and other forms of nature's handiwork are arrayed on all sides, presenting an immense mingling of the beautiful and the picturesque that is as rare as it is unusual.
