

### HUNTING SEASON TOLL IS 26 DEAD

Conservation Department Officials  
Back Information On  
Accidents

Department of Conservation officials are now compiling detailed data on hunting accidents in Michigan to determine the fundamental causes of the deaths of 26 men and the injuring of 38 others since Sept. 1.

Before the deer-hunting season opened 14 had been killed, most of them in duck hunting accidents. There were 11 fatalities during the deer hunting season. Seven were killed in the upper peninsula and four in the lower peninsula. During the deer season there was one fatality among rabbit hunters, a man accidentally exploding as two rabbit hunters were in their home preparing their guns for hunting. Twenty-three men were injured in one way or another during the deer season, the report shows. Six

were wounded when they were mistaken for deer in the woods; three were struck by stray bullets. One man was injured when a bullet aimed at a rabbit struck a tree and glanced back and struck him. One hunter lost an eye when a deer ran into the hunter's automobile. The deer's head went through the door window and the animal's prongs struck the driver in the left eye. A southern Michigan hunter was severely burned when his camp tent caught fire. Another hunter mistaken for a rabbit, was shot in the leg.

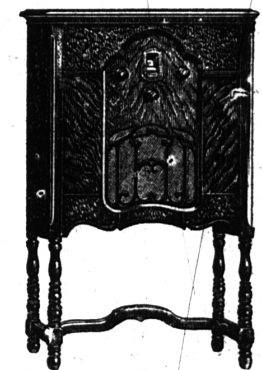

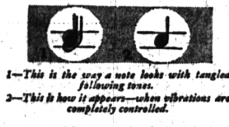
