

BOOKS INCREASE,
REPORT SHOWS

Resolution Gain Of 2,141 Books Indicated In Statement

A total gain in circulation of 41 for the month of November as that of November 1928 in the report indicated in the monthly report of the Baldwin Public Library. The total circulation this month numbered 2,191, of which 951 was school circulation; the circulation of the same month last year amounted to 7,000. The reading season is just getting started.

One hundred and sixty-five new books were added last month, bringing the total of books owned by the library to 11,739. There are 3,895 names registered in the library, 113 of these having been added during November.

November 24 marked the end of the second year of the library's history of its present quarters.

imral Elected

U. Of M. Grid Pilot

Ann Arbor, Mich. — James Ducky Simral, regular punter and safety man for the past two years, has been elected captain of a University of Michigan football team for 1930. His home is Lexington, Ky.

The new captain, who succeeds the late Alvin Karpis, is one of the youngest men ever elected to lead a Wolverine team, as he is only 20 years old.

"Simral" has had time taken for him just once in two years, and during the season just closed he set a new record for minutes played. He did not miss a minute of the last seven games at Michigan State, Purdue, Ohio State, Illinois, Harvard, Minnesota and Iowa. In all, he played 490 minutes on eight Saturdays, or 10 minutes over the equivalent of eight full games.

Felons Increase
Michigan's penal institutions have increased in population from 8,219 to 8,301 during the past year, according to the announcement made by Arthur D. Wood, adj. and parole commissioner, including the Chelsea Cement plant and road camps the prison at Jackson. There are 4,261 prisoners as against 3,830 in 1928. Life-term prisoners now confined are 551.
