Section 2: (Chapter 21) The Section 2: (Chapter 21) The commission may, either with or without petitions signed by parties and interest, by a two-thirds vote of the commission elset, order the following improvements to be made and paid for by special assessment not to exceed five-sixths of the whole cost upon the property to be benefited: sanitary sewers, drains, combined sanitary sewers, drains, combined sanitary sewers and surface drains, side-walks, street and alley cutters.
