ERNE NEVERS

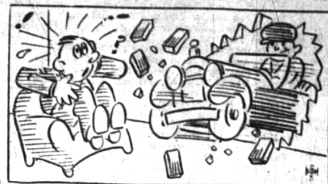

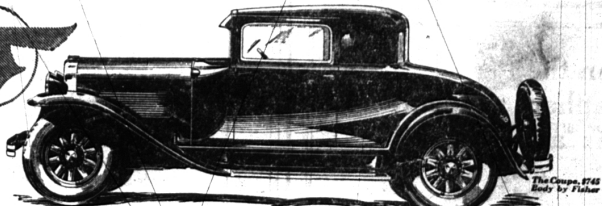
