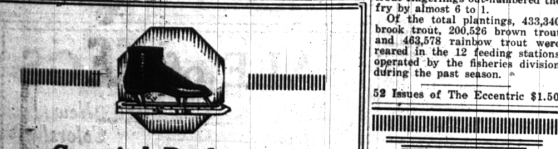

140 MILLION FISH PLACED IN LAKES
State Conservation Department Makes Report On Year's Work

Lansing, Jan. 2.—Nearly 140 million fish were planted in Michigan streams and lakes in 1928 up to the first week in December, according to the report made by Fred Westerman, superintendent of the fish hatcheries of the department of conservation. There were more than 12 millions of fingerlings planted while the fry and advanced fry made up the balance of nearly 128 million. Of the state's commercial species whitefish led all the rest with a total of 56,000,000.

The perch holds second position with a total of 36,126,250. The wall-eyed pike was third, the number being 21,000,469. There were 6,852,250 lake trout fry and fingerlings planted. According to the report, 10,692,296 brook trout were planted in the state. German browns totaled 5,079,868, while the rainbows numbered 2,160,137. There were 483,870 large mouth bass planted and 81,062 small mouth bass being placed in the Wolverine state's waterways.

The fingerlings made a fine showing in the trout classes. There were over 6 million brook trout fry and advanced fry released while those in the fingerling class totaled 4½ million. The German brown total was evenly divided between the two classes while the rainbow trout fingerlings outnumbered the fry by almost 6 to 1.

Of the total plantings, 433,340 brook trout, 300,523 brown trout and 463,578 rainbow trout were reared in the 12 feeding stations operated by the fisheries division during the past season.
