JUNE IS RECORD BUILDING MONTH

Total Of \$159,075.00 Is Amount Spent For New Building In Village

Surpassing May as the record month for 1929 building in the village June shows a total construction cost of \$159,075.00. May's figure was \$140,800.00, with 25 new buildings put up, the same number as in June.

These figures are made public today by Donald C. Egbert, building inspector, who has been at work in the village for the past fortnight.

Of this figure 20 new structures were put up at a total cost of \$153,775.00 while the report shows alterations on five buildings totaling \$5,300.00.

Ten of the new buildings are single residences with a total construction cost of \$131,500.00, while six are private garages constructed at approximately \$6,575.00. Four new business buildings went up during the month with the construction figures showing \$15,700.00.

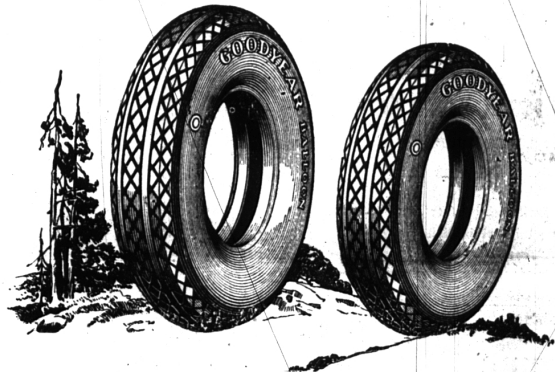
