FINISH DETENTION HOME ABOUT SEP. 1

County Structure Being Erected To Care For 100 Boys And Girls

With plastering well under way and all exterior work completed, the new Oakland County Detention Home, located near the infirmary, in Waterford Township, will be ready for occupancy Sept. 1, contractors say.

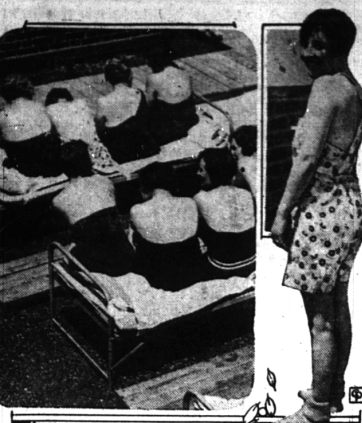
Built at a cost of \$25,000, the new structure will provide accommodations for 100 boys and girls. The building is constructed so the sexes can be segregated. It will house dependent and delinquent children. They also will be kept apart.

Features of the new home will include: A school division with class rooms and manual training and domestic science departments; a boys' gym and a girls' gym; a small hospital section with a dental laboratory and operating room and play rooms.

STATE FAIR TO PUT ON WORK FOR BOYS

1200 Alumni Of Boys' State Fair School Will Be Held Sept. 1 To 7

(Special To The Eccentric) Detroit, Mich., July 18.—Organization of the 1200 alumni of the Boys' State Fair School, numbering some of the most successful farmers in Michigan, will be undertaken at the eightieth annual exposition of the Michigan State Fair, Sept. 1 to 7. The school, established 15 years ago as an agricultural educational proposition, is made up of county winners of an annual state-wide agricultural contest. Selection of this year's students took place late in June.

The attempt in September will be the first to organize an alumni association. Invitations to attend are being sent to all former students. A huge tent will be pitched on the grounds to house the organization program. Annual meetings are guests of the fair.

The Boys' State Fair School is a prominent educational feature of the State Fair. Entrants in the annual contest which determines its students are selected mainly for their knowledge of farming, though any boy of good eighth grade standing is eligible. The test, however, is such that no boy not carefully prepared can enter and have a fair chance of victory. Previous winners are barred. The examination in each county is under the supervision of the school commissioner. At the fair the expenses paid, are guests of the fair management. They are housed and fed on the grounds, and given an intensive agricultural course and daily physical exercises under qualified instructors. Admission to all entertainment at the fair is free and the boys are taken on motor trips around Detroit.

The interest in both agriculture and the state fair aroused by these contents and selections has been so great, fair officials report, that many of the boys have become annual visitors to the fair, which prompts the organization of an alumni association.

MILITARY CAMPS AT CUSTER TO BE NAMED AFTER EDWIN DENBY

(Special To The Eccentric) Detroit, July 18.—The Citizens' Military Training Camps at Camp Custer, from July 19 to August 17 will be named Camp Edwin Denby, in honor of Detroit's famous citizen, sailor, marine and former secretary of navy, who died in Detroit in February, the war department has just announced.

In addition to honoring the memory of Colonel Denby the war department has announced that four streets at Camp Edwin Denby will be named in honor of four Michigan soldiers who died in the service of their country during the world war. All of these four soldiers served with the 339th Infantry regiment, 85th Division, in the Northern Russian campaign, and all were awarded the Distinguished Service Cross by the United States. The soldiers are: First Lieutenant Charles F. Chappel, First Lieutenant Clifford F. Phillips, Corporal William H. Russell and Private Victor Stier. The war department has also informed Major General Frank Park, commanding general of the Sixth Corp Area, that the quota for the sixth corps area has been increased 300, which will give Michigan an increase in its quota.

Colonel Frederick L. Knudsen, chief of staff of the 85th Division, has sent out a call to all Reserve officers in Michigan asking them to make a last effort to enroll young men between 17 and 24 years of age for Michigan's two training camps at Camp Custer and Fort Brady. Each Reserve officer is asked to get at least one young man to enroll.

Colonel Frederick L. Knudsen will not command the C. M. T. C. at Camp Custer this year, as was originally announced by the Sixth Corps Area headquarters last winter, but Colonel A. C. Gillem, who is now in command of the Reserve and R. O. T. C. unit, will remain on the job as commanding officer of Camp Edwin Denby.

Every young man in Michigan who desires to attend this year's C. M. T. C. will have to get his application in today in order to have it accepted. There is no time to waste now as the camp will open next Friday morning, and all young men from Michigan who have been accepted will have to report either at Camp Custer or Fort Brady during the day. Everything is arranged to meet the young men at depots, ferry-urban stations and bus stations, and at the camps. There will be regular army and reserve officers at

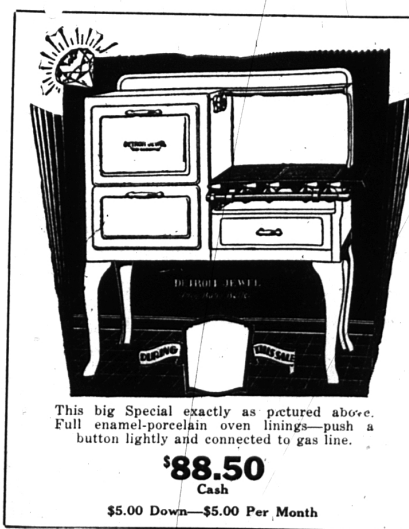
