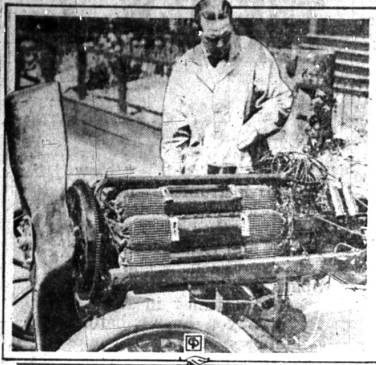

NEW PRIME MINISTER POSES WITH CABINET MEMBERS



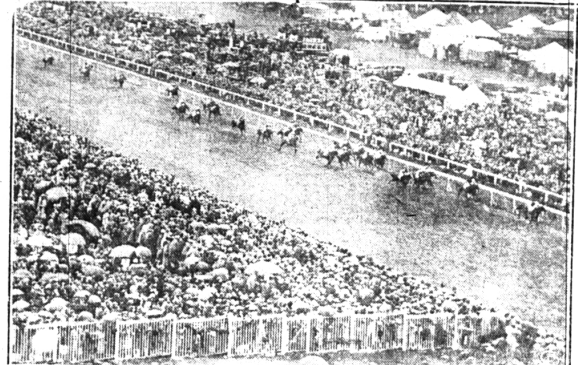

Fights Extradition



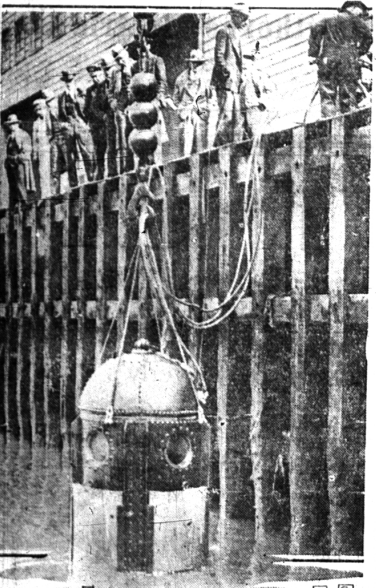
