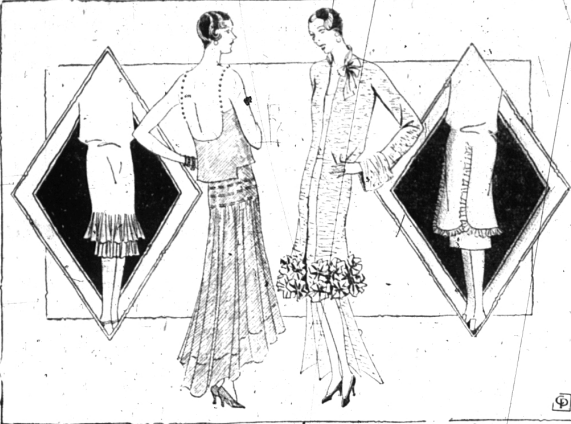

Skirts Show Length, Brevity On One Model

While the question of whether skirts will be long or short wavers, the long and the short of it is they are being both lengthened and abbreviated in one and the same model. Take, for example, the ensemble for formal wear sketched at the right center. Here the skirt is knee length in front, while it trails the floor at the back by means of a panel inserted below the pointed line of the hip yoke at the back. The material is pale blue moire, and the skirt hem is finished with a ruche of moire roses at the front and sides. The coat of the same material is finished with a like ruche which just reaches the ruche of the skirt.

model at the left center, which shows the extreme length of the skirt for evening wear. This is of brown tulle, fashioned with a dip in the back of the skirt, a joked hipline and a bolero bodice. Jeweled shoulder straps support the frock. Both models share the mode for evening wear as exploited in the latest Paris collections.

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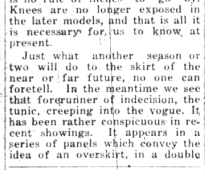
