For the second time Village Players showed almost professional ability in their presentation of a three-act bill. Noel Coward's "Hay Fever" presented last Friday and Saturday nights by the Players at their Playhouse was an even greater triumph than "Aren't We All," the three-act bill which marked the peak in Player's achievements.

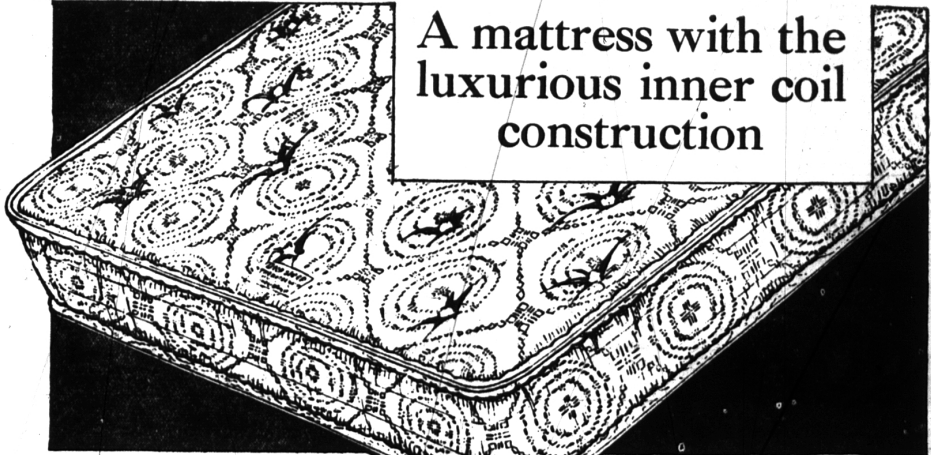
