

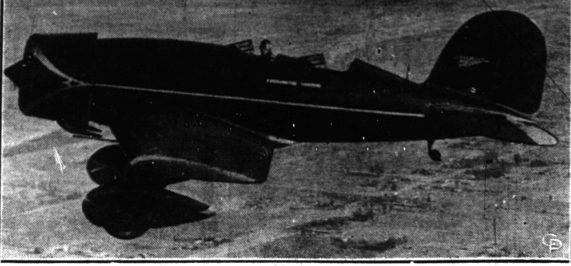
**Laura Schuler Buried Tuesday**

The objects of the board are listed as follows: 1. To unite the real estate brokers of this community for the purpose of exerting effectively a combined influence upon matters affecting real estate interests.

2. To enable its members to transact their business connected with the buying, selling, renting, caring for, and loaning of money on real estate to better advantage than heretofore, by the adoption of such rules and regulations as they may deem proper.

3. To promote and maintain the high standard of conduct in the transaction of the real estate business expressed in the Code of Ethics formulated by the National Association of Real Estate Boards and to enforce that code among its members in their dealings with one another and with the public.

4. To advance the civic development and the economic growth of this community.

5. To grant to its active and non-resident members the right to use the designation "Realtor" under the conditions established for that use by the National Association of Real Estate Boards.

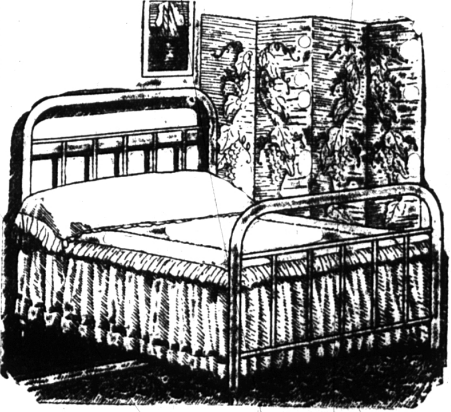
