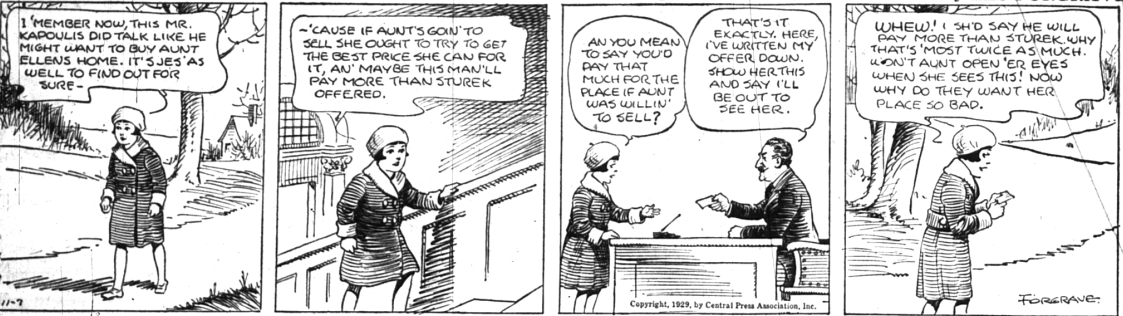

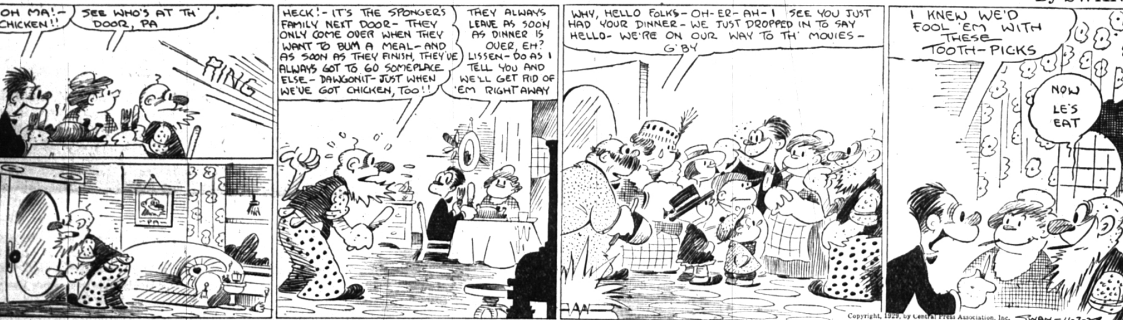

The Right Lamp in the Right Socket

Fourteen types of electric lamp bulbs are carried in stock by The Detroit Edison Company—an ample variety to fit almost any need. Standard inside-frosted lamps are available in five sizes: 15 watts, 25, 40, 60, and 100. In addition to these, the Company supplies a 25-watt tubular lamp (for use in show cases), clear lamps in five sizes (150 watts, 300, 500, and 1000), and white-bowl lamps (sizes 150 watts, 300 and 500).

The useful life of the modern, high-efficiency electric lamp is approximately 1,000 hours of illumination. After this period the glass bulb rapidly becomes blackened, and the lamp should be replaced. Blackened and burn-out lamps (in the ordinary size) are exchanged for new lamps without charge at any Detroit Edison office.
