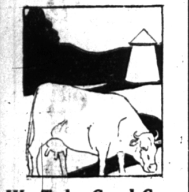

VILLAGE OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS Ordinance No. 22

An Ordinance Amending All of Ordinance No. 12, the same as amended, and Establishing a Building Code for the Village of Bloomfield Hills...

Section 1. Section 6 of Article XI of the Ordinance No. 12, entitled...

Section 2. The following regulations are hereby adopted...

Section 3. The provisions of this Ordinance relative to the storage handling and sale of fuel oil...

Section 4. Fuel oil shall mean any liquid used as fuel and having a flash point above one hundred thirty degrees Fahrenheit.

Section 5. Fuel oil burners shall mean any device including burner, motor, piping, valves and other equipment designed for the burning of fuel oil...

Section 6. "Asphyxiant tank" shall mean any tank between the storage tank and the burner device...

Section 7. "Bureau of safety engineering" shall mean the bureau of safety engineering of the department of buildings and safety engineering of the Village of the Building Inspector...

Section 8. Before any fuel oil burners, tanks and other equipment are installed...

Section 9. The tests and investigations made by the department of buildings and safety engineering shall cover arrangement of parts, suitability of material, strength of part, electrical control, thermostatic arrangement, sensitiveness of automatic features, positiveness of ignition, safeguards against flooding, possibilities of explosion and hydrostatic or air pressure test of storage tanks.

Section 10. Oil burners shall be equipped with such approved device, mechanical or electrical, which will automatically shut off the burner...

Section 11. All burners subject to automatic ignition must be provided with permanent automatic device...

Section 12. Standard full weight wrought iron, galvanized iron or steel or copper pipe shall be used throughout...

Section 13. Electrical installations used in connection with oil burning devices shall be installed in accordance with the National Electric Code...

Section 14. The burner shall be located in the smoke pipe or chimney from the place heated that may restrict to a dangerous extent the passage of fumes gases. Ventilation shall be provided to prevent the accumulation of any trapped vapors below the combustion chamber.

Section 15. Oil storage tanks on the inside of any building shall be located in the lowest story, cellar or basement...

one shall be permitted inside of any building but not more than two hundred twenty-five gallons shall be permitted in any one storage tank...

not less than one and one-half inches in diameter, extending to the outside of any building, and shall be properly capped at all times.
