## Alec the Great Tells Of Game's Changes In Past Fifteen Years

St. Louis.—"In the world's series of 1915 I opened the series against the Red Sox and beat them 3 to 1.

"The second game I worked the Sox beat the Phillies 2 to 1.

"The Boston team nicked me for eight hits in the game I won, and got but six hits when the beat me the next time out. And those games were about the general run. But the game has changed a lot since then.

Alexander had switched from stand. I've noticed, however, that young Carlson has been going fully good for the Cubs lately. If the going gets tough for the pitcher, he may prove to be an ace in the hole for the Cubs.

"I saw the Athletics in action last spring but their showing then wasn't an indication of their play now. The team was divided for the next time out. And spring exhibitions Connie himself was at a loss to figure out why his team was getting away so carelessly. He has a great team. Any team that can step out

the comparison of the Chicago Cubs and Philadelphia Mackmen probable opponents in the 1929 world's series, to a general discussion of conditions.

Low Score Games Rare  
"Low score games are rare nowadays. And with two teams of wreckers, like those the Cubs and Athletics carry, going into a series the scores are liable to be high.

"This is particularly true where two clubs that haven't any direct line on the style of play of the other follow meet.

"Both parks are made for long fly hitting. Which means that a pitcher's in trouble the minute a ball is hit out of the infield.

"A one-run lead means little these days. A two or three-run lead doesn't worry the team on the other fellow meet.

"We can get those back." "The New York Yankees, in one game a short time ago, slammed out seven runs at the start of the game against Detroit—and the Tigers came right back and tied it up. They were not making the pitching that the Cubs and Athletics can offer, but the difference in pitching can't wipe out the difference in the amount of scoring as against that of a dozen years ago.

Predicts Close Series  
"I look for a close series—as far as the outcome in victories and defeats. As the teams stand today, the margin of difference in the hitting strength of the clubs lies mainly in the added distance the Cub batters, as a crew, get to their hits. The Cubs haven't the change of pace, in the way of pitching, however, to toss against the Athletics that Connie Mack has—Grove with his speed ball, Walberg with his curve, Earnshaw with a good slow ball and change of pace. Nor has McCarthy a good left-hander to sandwich in with his right-handers.

The Cubs have Earnshaw, Cuyler and Grimm (if he's back), with world's series experience behind them. Not to mention on Connie's team has been in such a series. This may or may not mean anything.

"So much for the teams as they
