

# DRIVERS GET HEAVY FINES

### Three Men, Arrested in Bloomfield, Pay \$75 Each

Fines of \$75 each with alternatives of 40 days in jail were handed out to three motorists appearing before Justice Floyd S. Buck Tuesday on disorderly charges, in the holiday's toll of traffic violators.

Charged with disorderly conduct as he drove north on the wrong side of Woodward avenue, Quinton Roles, 92 Gerald street, Highland Park, Tuesday paid a fine of \$75 in Justice Floyd S. Buck's court. He was given an alternative of 40 days.
