The International Uniform Sunday School Lesson for July 6. A Man Who Found Friendship With God. Gen. 12:1-3; 13:7-12; Heb. 11:8-10.

It is interesting to note how much and activity have been associated with religious aspiration and motive. America was settled to a large extent by those who came to this country in quest of worship.

Getting Away from Idolatry. The distinction of Abraham religiously, however, was a pioneer in the sense that he urged him to leave his home in Ur, seeking new opportunities in Palestine.

Many believe that this movement was occasioned on Abraham's part by the senescence of Lot, his kinsman.

VAPLE LEAVES FOR NEW POST

Will Be Educational Director At Congregational Church in Detroit

George S. Yaple, who severed his connection with the Birmingham Community House Tuesday has been called by the deacons and board of trustees of the North Woodward Avenue Congregational church to be educational director of the church.

The North Woodward Avenue Congregational church, Mr. Yaple explained, is the largest Congregational church in Michigan and has recently made extensive additions to its personnel as well as to its chapel and lounge.

Mr. Yaple held the same position several years ago, and left in 1924 to become teacher of Old and New Testament History at Highland Park High School.

Long Lake Lodge, a summer camp for boys at Brighton, Me., is the immediate destination of Mr. Yaple. He will go there for his seventh consecutive summer, and is an associate director for the summer.

BEAUTIFUL Y. M. C. A. CAMP LODGE AT LOON LAKE OPENS ON JULY 6

The Oakland County Y. M. C. A. announces the opening of its new rustic camp lodge on the northern Loon Lake Camp Site, July 6, with 150 boys and leaders gathered for an experience in character education.

Frederick D. Madison, architect, the designer of many of the public buildings in this section of the state and particularly in this county, because of his great interest in our boyhood has found time out of his busy life not only to design this attractive building, but also to supervise its construction without cost to the camp trustees.

This rustic lodge of very simple but strong construction, 30 feet wide by 60 feet long, overlooks the lake from a beautiful wooded bluff, 60 feet above the lake level.

Along one end and a part of two sides is a porch 10 feet wide and 81 feet long. This porch, which adds a great deal to the attractiveness of the building, was made possible by a gift from one of the trustees. The exterior is covered with log siding stained a natural cedar log color.

Accommodates 150. The rear part of the interior is divided into a bank store, office, storage room and kitchen. The front part is a dining lodge to accommodate 150 persons. On one end is a large stone fire place built by Ora Billman, the Dean of Fire Place construction in Northern Michigan.

On June 30, the staff consisting of Orlo Crissey of Chicago University as Camp Director, Jack Lunn and his wife as Associate Director and business assistant, respectively; Mrs. Estelle Ferris and husband, as cooks, the business managers, and 10 tent counselors, most of whom are college men will gather at the camp for a week to prepare the camp for projects in character education which will be offered to the boys when they arrive. Each will have the opportunity of selecting the things he really likes to do.

Among the projects offered will be swimming, boating, nature study, group and team games, leather craft, metal craft, wood working, first aid, life saving, archery, hiking, canoeing, airplane models, reed work, clay modeling, soap carving, dramatics, pageantry, fishing and manufacture of rods, restoration, camp craft, cooking, music and camps.
