### Public Health Nurse Views Wide Range of Village Life

Home calls made by Mrs. Olga Benning, public health nurse, cover a wide range of village life. She is classed, strictly speaking, as a health visitor. Due to the frequency of her calls she has become well-known to her patients and their families, and is welcomed among them as a friend and fairy-godmother.

Mrs. Benning, who has been health nurse since year ago last spring, finds the greatest need for her services in South Birmingham.

Acting under the supervision of Dr. A. W. Newitt, village health officer, Mrs. Benning visits families whose members have need of medical attention but cannot afford to pay for it, or can pay for only part of the services. Her duties do not include bedside nursing but only instruction and recommendations. Indigent children with tonsils and adenoids, for example, are sent to Oakland County and state institutions.

Most persons are more than willing to follow out her instructions, Mrs. Benning finds, and have erred, if they have erred at all, through ignorance or poverty, rather than through obstinacy. Usually they tell the truth about their financial conditions, although, she says, one meets all kinds of people in her work.
