Ten monograms were awarded second string men, five for basketball and five for baseball, while 16 numerals were presented to second team men in basketball squad and Mark Wilson received a manager's letter for the basketball team. Ten track letters were to have been presented at the same program but they did not arrive in time for the ceremonies.

Under the new ruling established by the Student Board of Athletic Control, that all awards for sports be made during a final assembly program in the same semester in which the sport occurred, it was the first time that Baldwin High School cagers received letters for their services in making the season successful.

 Melvin C. Hart, principal of the Baldwin High School, opened the program with a brief address congratulating the athletes for their achievements and fine sportsmanship during the past year. Coach George Johnson and Coach Ernest Engel each reviewed the various seasons before the presentation of the letters to the men.

Coach Engel made 14 Baldwin Junior High baseball awards to junior high ball tossers and a manager's letter to H. Atwell. The Baldwin Junior High made its presentation of a gift to Coach Engel immediately after he gave out the letters.

The first letters ever to be given by the Baldwin High School in mail were presented to Philip Deaubien, Gerald Anderson, Maurice Winborn, George Shave and C. Elton Buck, III. Buck received a letter during the past year. Coach Engel presented a letter to five of his best men when the baseball candidates turned out next Spring with the few freshmen fielders and others who acquired experience this year he will have enough material to work out a good team.

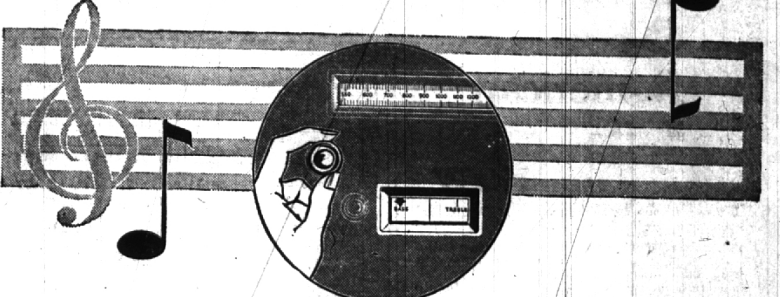

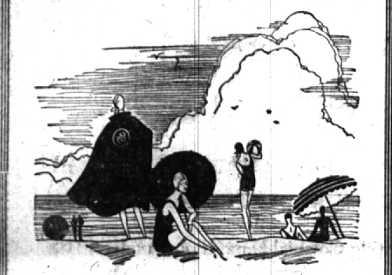
