Her brother, Jerry, age 9, and a playmate, Freddie Boycott, age 10, are in serious condition from burns while another brother, Robert, age 10, and Billie Drewport, age 8, sustained slight burns.

### ORAL HYGIENE LATEST STUDY AT UNIVERSITY

Ann Arbor, Mich., June 6.—Calling on the dentist will never become a popular pastime, but it holds less terrors every year. The comparatively new profession of oral hygiene is one of the reasons. For seven years the University of Michigan's School of Dentistry has offered courses in this field to young women who wish to become dentistry what the nurse is to medicine—a practitioner's assistant, herself a limited practitioner. There are about 2,082 oral hygienists, or dental hygienists, as they are sometimes called elsewhere, in the United States.

Oral hygiene as a profession, came into existence as the result of discoveries about the infectious and therapeutic treatments which can readily be carried out by other than fully qualified dental surgeons. By far the greatest number of young women in this field are in private practice, but many are in schools, hospitals and clinics. The business of these assistants is for the most part to aid in decreasing mouth diseases and teach personal care of the mouth.

Entrance requirements for admission to courses in this profession are the usual qualifications for entrance to college—a high school course successfully completed. The curriculum itself is at present a one-year course, consisting of lectures, as well as many of the lectures in the School of Dentistry.

The two distinct fields for this work are: work in the office of a dentist to give patients prophylactic and therapeutic treatments as well as to assist generally in certain operations or to teach in the public schools, where under the direction of a dentist they perform hygienic measures, or mouth hygiene, for children, and teach them care of the mouth.

Nurses who have had exceptional training in teaching, may obtain a certificate for oral hygiene in one semester. Those who operate in the public schools should have some teachers' training, at least the equivalent of two years. This makes a splendid field for women who have had training as teachers and who wish to qualify in this field of public health service.
