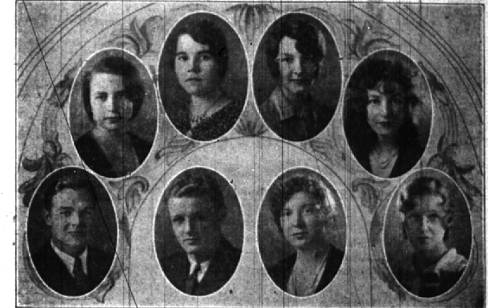

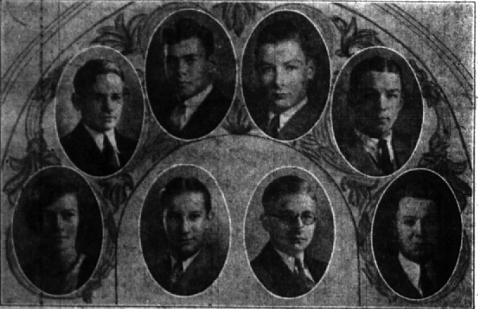
Dr. Paul Voelker, president of Battle Creek College, will give the commencement address in the high school on Thursday evening.

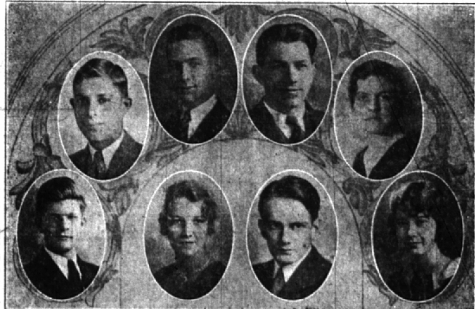

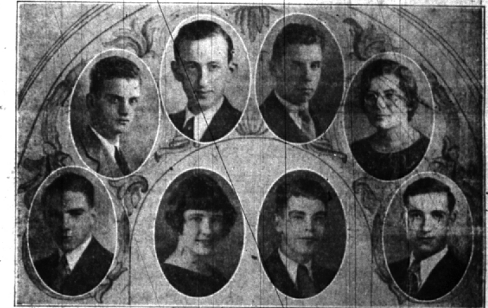

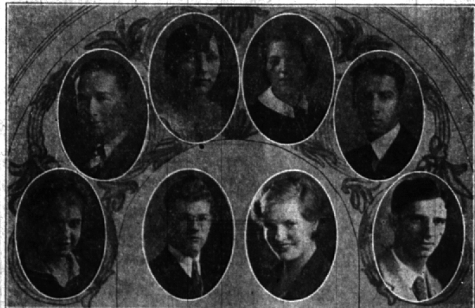
