### SPEED KINGS RACE SUNDAY

#### 100-Mile Auto Race Begins At 3 P. M. At State Fair Grounds Track

Speed kings of the world in their new two motor race cars are headed toward Detroit for the championship 100-mile A. A. sanctioned 100-mile race which is scheduled for the Michigan State Fair track, Sunday, June 8. Practically the entire crop of starters in the Indianapolis 500 miler has signed up for the Detroit race in which 14 cars are to start—all of them with a driver and a mechanic, this for the first time on speedway or any race track since 1922.

There is greater interest in the Detroit race than ever before and there is an international complexion to the speed battle for the only two foreign entrants at Indianapolis—riding in an eight and a 16-cylinder Maserati Spec. are coming to this city. They are Italians and flanking them will be the colorful Peter De Paola and the estate Tony Galotta, who are American born sons of Italy. Not since the halcyon days of the popular Ralph De Palma has there been one or more son of Italy in the race. Michigan will have an added

interest in the race because there are four drivers from Detroit who are sure, barring accidents, to be in the qualifying field. They are Shorty Cantlon, Wilbur Shaw, Chet Miller and Louis Schneider. Cantlon, Shaw and Miller are favorites with state auto race fans. They have known them and their heavy footed ability to drive for many years. This is the first time that Cantlon or Miller or Shaw will have started in an Indianapolis 500 miler-up behind cars that were built to stand up. Cantlon last fall won the state title at Flint, Mich.

W. D. Edburn, chief steward at Indianapolis, and who will run the Detroit race for which there are 570 points and approximately \$10,000 in prize money there will be a 25-mile race with 10 starters open to state cars and drivers.

PIKE'S PEAK IS STILL SEVERE AUTO TEST

Colorado Springs, Col., June 5.—A concrete example of the tremendous strides made by automotive engineers toward the goal of mechanical perfection in the modern motor car is provided here daily on the Pike's Peak highway.

A few years ago, a car that would scale the Peak was a front-page feature throughout the country, while today, thanks to the automotive engineer, a car's ability to perform ably and satisfactorily in the thin rarefied air and on the long steep ascents of the Peak is taken more or less for granted.

Despite a greatly improved highway up the Peak the long continuous climb and the light air pressure in the high altitudes, which used to mean a boiling radiator and an engine too hot to make the grade, provide one of the severest tests in America of the mechanical condition of a car.

Even more outstanding than the performance of those tourist automobiles which make a single trip up the steep incline is the record of a fleet of trucks used to maintain the highway in constant repair. The fleet now in such service includes three Chevrolet sixes which see almost daily use up in the region above the cloud-levels. Recently the fleet has been used to haul away huge mountains of snow to prepare the highway for the summer tourist travel. The route was expected to be opened early in June. With the snow cleared away, the fleet will continue in daily service doing maintenance and repair work on the highway.

### POLLUTION WARNING IS ISSUED BY CONSERVATION DEPARTMENT

Lansing, June 5.—A warning camped at the state parks alone. Had these been permitted to dump garbage in rivers and streams it would have meant pollution at the rate of approximately 70 tons a day, it was said. All these campers represent but a small proportion of those who camp in Michigan.

State law forbids the dumping of any garbage or refuse in any public waters; requires that it must be buried in the ground at least ten rods away from the water line, and provides for a penalty for its violation.

With hundreds of thousands of campers through the state each summer, it is obviously impossible to inspect all camp sites, it was said, and much of the responsibility for keeping Michigan's lakes and streams clean must rest with the camper himself.

It is conservatively estimated that each pound of garbage and refuse is dumped per day per person. Last year 138,398 people

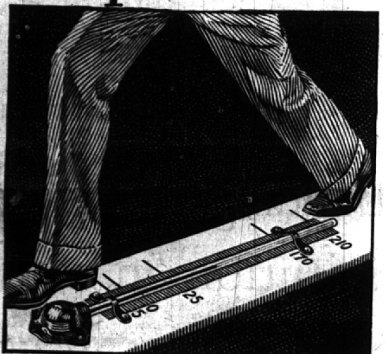

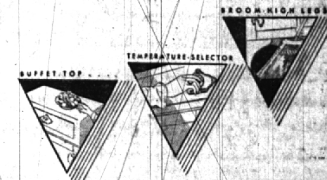

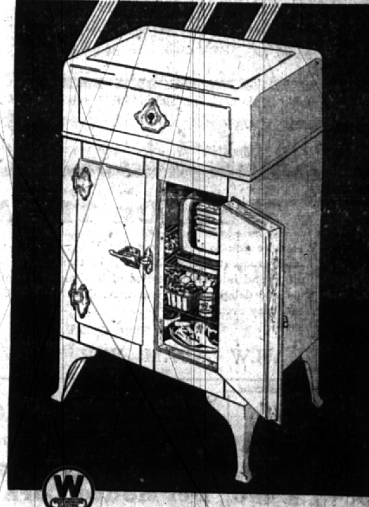
