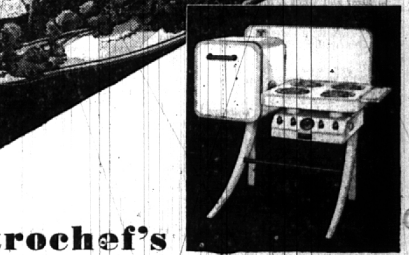


Would Avoid Darkness
