A. FEATHERSON, PIONEER, DIES

Village Native, 82, Was Born On First State Bank Site

Funeral services for Albert Featherston, a native of Birmingham, born on the site of the First State Savings Bank, will be held at 2 p. m. Saturday from his residence on Dodge road, the Rev. H. H. Savage officiating. Burial will be in Perry Mount Park Cemetery.

Soft of the late John and Sarah Jane Trellope Featherston who came to Birmingham from England in 1848, Albert Featherston was born Oct. 28, 1848 and three years later taken to the new family homestead on the Dodge road, now a part of the Fisher estate, one mile north and one-half mile east of the Auburn road.

In 1872 Mr. Featherston married Miss H. Amelia Postall. She died Aug. 15, 1904, and Mr. Featherston later married Miss Jennie McLanahan, for whom he lived on his farm, formerly the John H. Martin farm, and is said to have operated the first traction engine for threshing in Oakland County. From 1899-1903 he was chief engineer at the Pontiac State Hospital.

Besides his widow, Mr. Featherston is survived by a son, Harry J. of Pontiac.
